
<u>Day01, 31/08/11(Wed)</u> **KUALA LUMPUR / VANCOUVER** Late afternoon flight departure to Vancouver.

# Day02, 01/09/11(Thu) **VANCOUVER**

Safe arrival at Vancouver in the late evening. You will be transferred to hotel for check-in. As the host city for 2010 Olympic Winter Games, Canada's west coast gem of Vancouver is young, thriving and diverse, with the perfect combination of wild natural beauty and the modern conveniences of a city. Named after Royal Navy sea captain George Vancouver, who sailed into the Burrard Inlet on the British Columbian coast in 1792, Vancouver was barely even a town 100 years ago. Today more than two million people call it home, and the shiny futuristic towers of Yaletown and the downtown core contrast dramatically with the snow-capped mountain backdrop, creating a laid back atmosphere amongst the bustle of Canada's third biggest city.

# <u>Day03, 02/09/11(Fri)</u> VANCOUVER / EMBARK CELEBRITY CENTURY

Early morning after breakfast, free at leisure before your transfer to Vancouver cruise terminal for your cruise embarkation. Celebrity Century sets sail from Vancouver this late afternoon and heads north. You will have plenty of time to settle in to your cabin, enjoy a delicious meal onboard and a relaxing evening as you look forward to the experiences that await you in Alaska. Celebrity Century caters your fantasies. # Day04, 03/09/11(Sat) INSIDE PASSAGE CRUISING

Settle in to your luxurious new surroundings and enjoy the comforts of your cruise as it makes its way through the islands of the Inside Passage. Alaska's Inside Passage is the area that makes up the Southeast Region of Alaska. Approximately 1,000 miles North of Vancouver, it was the center of activity during Alaska's 19th century Gold Rush. Shaped by the carving of massive glaciers millions of years ago, it is an astounding region of deep fjords, glaciers, majestic mountains and forests. Known as the 'panhandle', it epitomises classic Alaskan scenery. The Inside Passage area is home to Tlingit, Haida Indians whose history is carved in towering totem poles. Russian settlers of these Alaskan communities left a legacy of onion-domed churches.

# Day05, 04/09/11(Sun) ICY STRAIT POINT, ALASKA

Today, your cruise makes its first call at Icy Strait Point, established in 1912 is a new port of call for cruise lines and enthusiasts of the real Alaska. Located near the city of Hoonah, Icy Strait Point opens its untouched, pristine lands to visitors. Hosting only "one ship at a time", it is the perfect location to discover the culture of the Tlingit people who have been natives of this land for thousands of years. This area is home to humpback whales, orca, Dall's porpoises, seals, sea otters, brown bear, halibut, and all five species of Pacific salmon. It is not uncommon to spot a humpback or an orca while walking along the shore and on many days, multitudes of bald eagles can be seen.



#### Day06, 05/09/11(Mon) HUBBARD GLACIER CRUISING

Continuing north, Hubbard Glacier is today's highlight. At over 90 miles in length, 300 feet in height and six miles across, the gigantic Hubbard Glacier is doubtlessly one of nature's wonders. Existing as the largest tidewater glacier in North America, it is also known as the "Galloping Glacier" because of the fact that it once advanced so far in a single day, it dammed Russell Fjord. This followed with the formation of a lake behind the dam that climbed to levels of 90 feet above sea level. Although the dam no longer exists, Hubbard Glacier still flows rather quickly and maintains the deep blue color that distinguishes it as being active glacial ice, it creaks and groans as it moves and is a very actively calving glacier. This makes for some exciting moments when the huge chunks of ice crash into the Bay creating a wonderful sound called 'white thunder' by the Tlingit people.

# Day07, 06/09/11(Tue) JUNEAU, ALASKA

Arrival at Juneau, the capital of Alaska this morning. Juneau was founded during a gold rush in 1880. Today, it is the cruise ship passengers who pack the streets every summer, enjoying the shopping, dining and picturesque surroundings. Situated among mountains on the shores of the Gastineau Channel, the former gold-mining town counts among its riches some of Alaska's most spectacular scenery. Juneau's attractions include the Mount Roberts Tram and the Mendenhall Glacier, Alaska's most visited glacier due to its easy access and proximity to the city. Glacier Bay National



Park is one of the country's more dramatic regions and is also accessible from Juneau, by boat or plane.

## Day08, 07/09/11(Wed) KETCHIKAN, ALASKA

Returning southward from Juneau, your cruise docks at Ketchikan this morning. Ketchikan, with an estimated population of 7,368 in 2010, is known as the 'Salmon Capital of the World'. It is built along a steep hillside, with sections of the town built right over the water on pilings. The rustic boardwalk on Creek Street preserves a distinct historic feel. Native art and culture flourish here due to the large population of Native Alaskans, represented by three indigenous tribes: the Tlingit, Haida and Tsimshian. Ketchikan has the largest collection of totem poles in the world, and has been recognized as one of the top hundred arts communities in America.



## Day09, 08/09/11(Thu) INSIDE PASSAGE CRUISING

Today your cruise threads her way through the Inside Passage heading for Vancouver, and your final opportunity to make the most of the onboard activities and entertainment. Get ready for some fun and relax poolside - or pamper yourself at the onboard AquaSpa. The remarkable spa treatments will take any stress off your mind and leave you blissfully relaxed. Wander around the ship and discover the huge lobby and the Boulevard with lots of great shopping. Breakfast at hotel. Enjoy a ferry cruise through beautiful Active Pass in the Gulf Islands to our quaint capital. Marvel at the spectacular ever-changing Butchart Gardens. We'll drive the scenic route into Victoria and the Inner Harbour.
