Early morning safe arrival at London. You will be transferred to Southampton cruise port for your cruise embarkation. Celebrity Eclipse sets sail from Southampton this late afternoon. Celebrity eclipse makes her maiden voyage in 2010. It has more than 90% accommodation that faces out to the sea and 85% feature balconies. The cabins are approximately 10% larger than that of their competitors but it is the thought and clever space-saving designs make the cabins feel even larger.

# Day03 10/06/2012(Sun) BRUGES (ZEEBRUGGE), BELGIUM

Bruges has the distinction of being Europe's best-preserved medieval city and Belgium's most popular tourist destination, a veritable 13th-century 'open air museum'. Berlin is best known for its historical associations as the German capital, for its internationality and tolerance, for its lively nightlife, for its many cafes, clubs, and bars, and for its numerous museums, palaces, and other sites of historic interest. Berlin's architecture is quite varied. Although badly damaged in the final years of World War II and broken apart during the Cold War, Berlin has reconstructed itself greatly, especially with the reunification push after the fall of the Berlin Wall in 1989.



# Day06 13/06/2012 (Wed) AT SEA

Spend the day at sea while you enjoy the comforts of your cruise. # <u>Day08-09 15-16/06/2012(Fri-Sat)</u> **ST. PETERSBURG, RUSSIA**Awake on day 8 in the knowledge that you have entered the

Russian waters, docking at St Petersburg. The city has an elegance also reminiscent of cities like Paris, London and Vienna, but is at the same time too Russian to be European, and beguiles with a



charm of its own. St Petersburg became the capital of Russia in 1712. Although the Russian capital moved to Moscow after the Revolution, the city remains the principal artistic and cultural centre of the country. You are fortunate enough to find yourself in St. Petersburg in June in which you get to revel in the city's famous "white nights," when the boundless night sky is never completely dark. Two days in St. Petersburg gives you opportunity to truly explore this amazing city.





# Day10 17/06/2012 (Sun) TALLINN, ESTONIA

Tallinn, the capital of Estonia is today's highlight. It is one of the oldest cities on the Baltic Sea, founded in 1154. Its Old Town has remained remarkably unchanged for the past 600 years, enabling visitors to enjoy architectural marvels of year past. While preserving its past Tallinn is as forward-looking and progressive as any other modern European capital. This is probably best reflected in the interactive exhibits at the Tallinn Science and Technology Centre, the city's showcase for the arts and sciences. Public transport is modern and efficient; the nightlife is pumping from cigar bars and pool halls to nightclubs.

# Day11 18/06/2012 (Mon) STOCKHOLM, SWEDEN

Arrival at Stockholm, the capital of Sweden this morning. The city is made up of 14 islands connected by some 50 bridges on Lake Mälaren, which flows into the Baltic Sea and passes an archipelago with some 24,000 islands and islets. Over 30% of the city area is made up of waterways and another 30% is made up of parks and green spaces, giving Stockholm perhaps the freshest air and widest lungs of any European capital. Stockholm has a stunning Old Town (Gamla Stan), a warren of narrow cobbled-stone streets overshadowed by historic houses, radiating out from the sumptuous Royal Castle where Swedish monarchs have resided since the 13th century. Despite the medieval heritage, Stockholm is no staid, old-fashioned enclave.

# Day12 19/06/2012 (Tue) AT SEA

After a couple of busy days visiting some of Europe's best sights, you will have the chance to just sit back and enjoy the facilities onboard. Pamper yourself, work up a sweat, or enjoy an enriching seminar. Enjoy some 'me time' at the amazing AquaSpa, Alternatively, go relax at the Solarium where you can sink into a comfortable lounge chair or take a refreshing dip in the pool. # Day13-14 20-21/06/2012(Wed-Thu) COPENHAGEN, DENMARK

Over breakfast today you will enjoy the sights of Copenhagen harbor as you glide into the capital of Denmark. From its humble beginnings, Copenhagen has become the largest city in Scandinavia, home to 1.8 million people, the seat of one of the oldest kingdoms in the world. Copenhagen is a city with much charm, as reflected in its canals, narrow streets, and old houses. Spend two days exploring this amazing city. Surrounded by a sea of

blooming flowers in Tivoli Gardens or admiring Copenhagen's famous Little Mermaid statue, visit Amalienborg Palace, where you can catch the changing of the guards, or Kronberg Castle, the famous setting of Shakespeare's Hamlet.

# Day15 22/06/2012 (Fri) AT SEA

When the sun goes down, night-life on board ship is just beginning. The Eclipse Theatre provides a venue for fabulous shows, musical performances and side-splitting comedy while Celebrity Central is an intimate venue for movies, live music and cabaret. Martini Bar & Crush is a hip cocktail bar with an intimate alcove serving vodka and caviar on ice. There are live bands and themed parties in the atrium and Sky Observation Lounge, which is being transformed into a British pub with quizzes and games on selected nights. Try your luck at the Fortunes Casino or perhaps this is simply your favorite time to gaze at the night sky from the seclusion of your stateroom.

Other famous landmarks include Buckingham Palace, the London Eye, Piccadilly Circus, 30 St Mary Axe ("The Gherkin"), St Paul's Cathedral, Tower Bridge and Trafalgar Square. London is home to numerous museums, galleries, libraries, sporting events and other cultural institutions including the British Museum, National Gallery, British Library, Wimbledon and 40 theatres.
